




ADOT FY 2024 HURF REVENUE FLOW CHART

Roughly half of HURF is directed to ADOT, the other half to county/ municipal road systems

Gas\$545.4M30%Use Fuel\$271.7M15%Registration\$241.4M13%VLT\$589.9M33%


Motor Carrier	\$58.4M	3%

Federal Funding for Arizona:


Dramatic increase from the enactment of the IIJA

Graphic depicts formula funding only, also dramatic increase in grant opportunities

ADOT 2050 LONG RANGE TRANSPORTION PLAN



- Revenue/Needs Gap Projected at \$162.3B

- Averages out to \$6.5B a year every year in under-investment through 2050



HURF Purchasing Power

HURF per capita purchasing power is just 33% of what it was in 1990, the last time Arizona's fuel tax was adjusted.
